Dear Families,

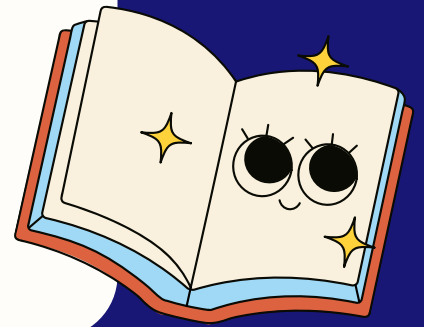

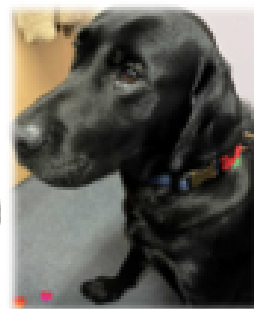

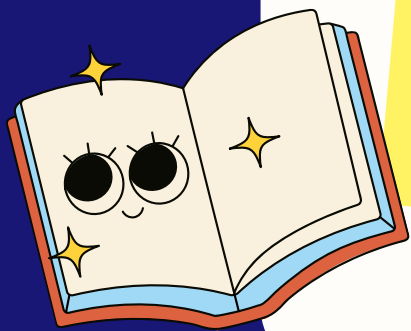

STEM Week

In DT Year 1 built towers using only newspapers and masking tape and then in Maths we explored volume and capacity and recorded findings in a table.



HIGHLIGHTS of THE WEEK



Year 3 recently explored the work of designer Finn Juhl, using it as inspiration to design and build their own chairs from newspaper. As part of our STEM D&T focus, the children showed great curiosity, experimenting with different ways to make their structures strong and stable.

The challenge was to create a chair sturdy enough for Rocky, our school dog (the teddy version), to sit on during the holidays. Through testing and improving their designs, pupils developed problem-solving skills and resilience.

We were impressed by their creativity and thoughtful designs—Rocky now has a fantastic set of chairs to enjoy!



HIGHLIGHTS of THE WEEK



In Science this week, we explored how magnets can move metal objects without touching them. By using a magnet under the paper, we were able to guide a paper clip through a maze. This showed us how the magnetic force can work through materials like paper.

We also tested different things to see what would happen. We tried using different thicknesses of paper to see if the magnet could still move the paper clip. We also added pictures or stickers to the paper clip to see how extra weight changed the way it moved.

From our exploration, we learned that magnets can pull metal objects from a short distance, but thicker materials and heavier objects can make it harder for the magnet to move them. This helped us understand more about how magnets work.
