


When studying Geography at All Saints' Primary, pupils will gain a thorough understanding of the key concepts/elements below. Each component is revisited throughout the year group to build upon pupils' understanding.



Year 2

To compare and contrast the human and physical geography of a small area of the UK, with a small area in a non-European country. To use aerial photographs, simple compass directions and locational and directional language to devise a simple map; and use and construct basic symbols in a key.

Year 1

To use atlases and world maps to name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans, and identify the UK and its countries. To identify weather patterns in the UK and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles, using the basic vocabulary of human and physical features.

EYFS

The children build foundational knowledge and skills in preparation for the KS1 Geography Curriculum. This includes: looking at and discussing the weather; the four seasons of the year; learning about our local area (my home, my school, my village, my town); learning about The World (what is in it, what is alive, what has changed); getting started with maps (my local area and The World).
