


History- A Whole School Journey

Te focus on significant

To focus on significant individuals both worldwide and from our local area who have contributed to national and international achievements. Within this study, the children will compare life in different periods of time. Pupils will also study a significant event beyond living memory and the impact this had.

Year 1 To understand where people and events they study fit within a chronological framework and identify similarities and differences between ways of life in different periods. To learn about events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally.

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Children will develop the ability to talk about the lives of the people around them. They will begin to know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now.
